

## The little agronomists

Long term project „The little agronomists“ that gives children the opportunity to independently grow and observe plants.

Children aged 2-7 years participated in the project. Children sowed, planted and grew various plants. They looked at various seeds, their differences, watched how plants sprouted and grew. Tried to grow them in different conditions (in the sun, in the dark, with and without watering). they took care of the plants grown in the greenhouse. The harvested crop was counted, weighed and compared. Later, they tasted home-grown fruits and vegetable
